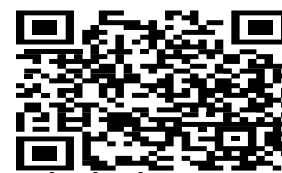

SCHOLARSHIP ADVERTISEMENT –2025 INTAKE

The African Canadian Continuing Education Society (ACCES) is a Non-Profit Organization that has been supporting education in Kenya since 1993. The mission of ACCES is to help children and youth in Africa to obtain the skills and education needed to benefit themselves and their society. In 2025, ACCES will offer partial scholarships to young Kenyans from Busia, Bungoma, Kakamega and Vihiga Counties. Eligible applicants must be needy, bright, have a record of satisfactory educational achievement, and **MUST** have an admission letter to or be enrolled in a public College or university accredited with Kenya National Examination Council (KNEC.) or Kenya University and College Central Placement Service (KUCCPS). This advertisement is valid from **1st February 2025 to 30th May 2025.**

Eligibility Criteria:

To be eligible for consideration, the applicant must meet the following minimum criteria:

- ☐ Must be a Kenyan Citizen, below 30 years of age, and from Busia, Bungoma, Kakamega and Vihiga Counties.
- ☐ Must have a minimum **KCSE** grade of **C Minus** for college and **C+** for university.
- ☐ TVET students are eligible to apply.
- ☐ For those already attending College/University and meet the above grades, must maintain a minimum grade B and above in academic performance.
- ☐ Incomplete applications will not be considered
- ☐ Must be either enrolled or have an admission letter to a Kenyan learning institution accredited with the KNEC or KUCCPS. **Post-Graduate Program Students are not eligible.**
- ☐ **Must** demonstrate the need for financial assistance by providing supporting documents outlining family circumstances as outlined on “**ACCES 2 FORM**”. Recommendation letters alone, without other supporting documents, will not be sufficient.

Selection Procedure:

1. **Application process:** ACCES will only accept applications for partial post-secondary scholarships on or before the **30th of May 2025**. To apply, kindly fill out the “**ACCES 2 FORM**” found either:
 - At all County and Sub- County government ministry offices and Administration Offices in **Bungoma, Busia, Kakamega and Vihiga Counties.**
 - At the ACCES Office in Kakamega in Milimani Estate, off state house road
 - Online at www.acceskenya.org
 - Or send an email to accescholarship@gmail.com with your e-mail address for the application form to be forwarded to you.
2. **Shortlisting & Interview Process:** Only shortlisted applicants will be notified for an interview. If you do not hear from us by the **20th of June 2025** consider yourself unsuccessful.
3. **The information that you provide during the interview shall be confirmed through an announced home visit in July, 2025.**
4. **Awarding ACCES Scholarships:** Successful applicants will receive a partial college or university scholarship from ACCES from the **end of September 2025.**

- This scholarship only applies to bright and needy undergraduate (**KUCCPS**) students in TVET, college and university accredited by either **KUCCPS** or **KNEC**. Post-graduate students are not eligible. Any student wishing to be considered for a scholarship must meet the eligibility criteria, submit a fully completed and signed application form, and include copies of academic certificates and supporting documents as required.
- Complete all sections in **CAPITAL/BLOCK LETTERS** using black ink. A (*) indicates that supporting documents are required. Please print clearly.
- This application form must be submitted to the ACCES office by **30th May 2025 at 5:00 p.m.** using the above address, otherwise it will be marked as late and will not be considered for the partial scholarship.
- ACCES scholarships are only available to students who are residents of **Kakamega, Bungoma, Busia and Vihiga** counties.
